








## WRONG CHOICES IN CLASS

	<p><b><u>Step 1:</u></b> A warning look</p>
	<p><b><u>Step 2:</u></b> 3 verbal warnings (1,2,3 Magic) Time out in class</p>
<p>1</p>	<p><b><u>Step 3:</u></b> Amber card 1 Part of playtime missed</p>
<p>2</p>	<p><b><u>Step 4:</u></b> Amber card 2 Isolate within the classroom Lunchtime missed with Headteacher / Deputy</p>
<p>3</p>	<p><b><u>Step 5:</u></b> Amber card 3: see Head / Deputy Report issued</p>
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• If you receive 3 Amber cards in 1 week = Report</li> <li>• If you receive more than one fail a day whilst on report = Isolation</li> </ul>	
	<p><b><u>Red card</u></b> Very serious incident See Headteacher Report/seclusion/exclusion</p>

## EYFS

### **Fantastic Board**

- I put my name on the fantastic board for all my friends to see.
- This gets celebrated within class during the day.

### **Instant Feedback**

- I get instant feedback about my positive choices, good learning, being a good friend and showing resilience.
- Sometimes, the whole class is stopped to hear about what I have done and they send me a positive 'Woosh!'

### **Smiley Faces**

- I get a smiley face stamp on my hand when I have made positive choices, shown good learning, been a good friend or shown resilience.

### **Stickers**

- I also get stickers throughout the day (In the same way as smiley face stamps).
- When I fill 'My super 20' sticker chart, I am given a certificate to share with my family. This certificate is given to me at home time and celebrated with all my friends.

### **Certificates**

- I get a certificate for filling my sticker chart.
- I can also get a certificate for being a super 'home reader'. These are presented during our weekly singing assembly and are celebrated in front of parents and carers.

### **Dinner Tickets**

- The midday supervisors may give me a dinner ticket if I have displayed positive behaviours during lunch time.
- I get to tell my friends what I did to achieve this after lunch.
- I may get an extra certificate and badge from a weekly draw.

### **Good to be green**

- Each term, I have the opportunity to celebrate my successes with the whole class by taking part in something fun. This might include popcorn and a film, bouncy castles or a crafty fun day!

### **Postcards home/Message to parents on Dojo**

- I may get a postcard sent home or a direct message on Class Dojo celebrating my successes directly with my parent/carers.
