Caldecote Community Primary School Uniform Policy

Principles

Our school uniform has proved very popular and children are encouraged to wear it to feel part of our school community. We also believe it is important that certain activities are facilitated by specialised and appropriate clothing when attending school, or when participating in a school organised event outside of school. We provide details of the items children may wish to wear and further information is given in our school prospectus.

Aims

Our policy for children's school uniform is based on the belief that a school uniform:

- Promotes a sense of pride in the school
- Engenders a feeling of community and belonging
- Is practical and smart
- Identifies the children with the school
- Makes children feel equal to their peers in terms of appearance
- Is regarded as suitable, and good value for money, by most parents
- Has been designed with health and safety in mind

Our colours are royal blue and white and the uniform is as follows:

- Royal Blue sweatshirt or cardigan with or without school logo
- White polo shirt with or without school logo
- Grey or black trousers, tracksuit bottoms, shorts or skirts/dresses without logos
- No jeans

- Plimsolls

Optional items

- Royal blue fleece with school logo
- Royal blue cap with school logo
- Royal blue reversible jacket with school logo

School Uniform Grant

Caldecote support assisting all our families using the School Uniform Grant. We can assist families with providing school clothing should they meet our criteria. Parents should make a request as needed.

In addition to this we often provide additional clothing that has been 'left in school' over the individual terms.
